WHAT: On Monday, April 10, YoungArts welcomed nearly 300 of New York City's top cultural and community leaders, philanthropists, celebrities and art aficionados to the annual YoungArts New York Gala at The Metropolitan Museum of Art's Temple of Dendur. The festive evening celebrated YoungArts and artists in the cultural capital of New York and across the nation. Presented by UBS Financial Services, Inc., the event was hosted by gala honorary chair Agnes Gund, and co-chairs Sarah Arison, Gillian Hearst and Sandra Tamer. The YoungArts annual New York Gala raised nearly \$1 million to support artists nationwide.
